Main Purpose of the role

- To collaborate with key community groups and stakeholders to implement and promote participation of the new 'Fit for Purpose' initiative across Bury, Greater Manchester
- To contribute to the measuring and reporting of outcomes to partner organisations.
- To contribute to the development and delivery of the wider Sunnywood events that promote the ethos of EXPLORE, LEARN, and GROW.

Responsibilities:

- Plan and lead quality outdoor-oriented sessions for young people with the aim of improving their mental, physical, and social wellbeing.
- Assist with reporting and communicating of youth provision outcomes to key partners including schools.
- Develop and implement engaging, interactive, and creative training opportunities for Volunteers.
- Lead, plan and schedule an engaging programme for the new Fit for Purpose initiative in collaboration with key community groups.
- Build positive working relationships with varied and diverse community groups to ensure successful implementation of Fit for Purpose initiative.
- Regularly evaluate and assess the effectiveness of the Fit for Purpose initiative and adjust activities as needed.

- is passionate about the outdoors and working with a wide range of people

What is Fit for Purpose:

Fit for Purpose is a new initiative launching in 2024 that aims to combine physical activity with social action to improve community cohesion and wellbeing.

For example, a group activity to improve fitness, such as a social 5km run, could incorporate completing a short task as a group that positively benefits the local community or environment leading to improved community cohesion and sense of belonging.

- Footpath maintenance
- Gardening
- Tree planting
- General community centre maintenance
